The Indigenous Land Stewardship (ILS) program offers students career preparation in land and resource management as well as a gateway to higher education. The program is currently seeking **Casual Instructor(s)** for the following courses:

- **ILS 100 - Introduction to Land Stewardship**
  - This course explores the natural and cultural foundations of land stewardship with a focus on Indigenous communities in British Columbia.
- **ILS 120 – Indigenous Environmental Knowledge**
  - Students will learn how different world views have developed among nations in BC and Canada, and how Indigenous knowledge systems can be used as tools for better land and resource management.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

Any combination of education and work experience as follows will be considered:

- Bachelor's degree in a related field (Master's or PhD preferred);
- at least 2 years experience in a relevant field;
- Significant teaching experience, preferably in the post-secondary education system;
- Excellent verbal, written and computer communication skills;
- Knowledge of Indigenous values, communities and instructional methodology, and experience working with Indigenous organizations and Indigenous adults.
